Huatulco Pickleball Club Rules & Regulations Pickleball Club Huatulco

Court Hours

Monday to Sunday

Morning: 6:30 am - 12:00 pm Afternoon: 4:00 pm - 9:00 pm

Open Play

To ensure optimal use of the courts during peak hours, the following play systems will apply depending on the number of players present.

"Winner Stay and Split": 27 players or less, the winning team stays on the court, but the players split up to form new teams. This way, the players who won the previous match become opponents in the next game.

"Paddle Stacking": 28 players or more, the players waiting to play must place their paddles in the designated area. At the end of each match, all four players leave the court, and the next four players in line take the next available court, in the order of arrival.

Match Rules

Scoring: Games are played to 11 points. You must win by at least 2 points.

Double Bounce Rule: The ball must bounce once on each side before volleys are allowed.

Non-Volley Zone ("The Kitchen"): No volleying is allowed within this zone.

Line Calls: In non-official games, players are expected to make fair calls. If there is any doubt whether the ball was "in" or "out," the point must be replayed.

Code of Conduct & Facility Use

Respect: All players must act with respect and courtesy toward fellow players, opponents, and club staff. Any inappropriate behavior should be reported in writing to the Club Committee for review and follow-up.

Cleanliness: Keep courts and common areas free of trash and personal belongings.

Equipment: All equipment (paddles, balls, nets, chairs, blower, batteries) must be stored properly after use. Return everything in the same condition and order it was found. Ensure locks are properly secured and lights in all 5 courts are turned off when done.

Maintenance: The club is committed to maintaining facilities in optimal condition. Please help us keep it that way & report any issues or anomalies to club management.



Injuries & Accidents: The club is not responsible for any personal injuries or accidents that may occur. Pushing, intentional collisions, or any unsafe behavior is strictly prohibited.

Compliance & Oversight

The club reserves the right to monitor compliance with these rules.

Failure to comply may result in penalties, including temporary or permanent suspension from the club.

These regulations aim to ensure a safe, fair, and enjoyable environment for all players, promoting a respectful and responsible sportsmanship.
